Celebrate with a mask

With great joy and gratitude we look back on the past services in the Parkarena. In the midst of extraordinary circumstances, we were able to encounter God during worship times, let ourselves be inspired by the sermons and enjoy moments of fellowship together. The mask plays an important role at the moment. It makes it possible that the worship service is accessible to many visitors. With the next step, the continuous mask obligation, we will be able to remove even more hurdles for attending the service.

With the new provisions of the Federal Council regarding major events, the Association of Free Churches (VFG - Freikirchen.ch) has once again updated its protection concept as of 1 October 2020. With this step, the continuous wearing of the protective mask will allow the further restrictions imposed by contact tracing to be lifted. From the beginning of October, ticket reservation, admission control and capacity restrictions will therefore no longer apply. In addition, the seat can again be freely selected. The distance and hygiene guidelines continue to apply as usual for the protection of all of us.

We are aware that wearing a mask is not equally comfortable for all visitors to the service. At the same time, this simple measure enables us to open our doors wide again and make the inspiring church services accessible to people with higher security needs. You could say: A small step with a big effect.
